Hufvudstaden welcomes MAX Burgers to Kungsgatan

We have a forward-looking expansion strategy involving rapid growth and have long wanted to open in the most central parts of Stockholm. There is considerable demand from people who work, shop and visit the Stureplan area to eat Sweden's tastiest burgers," says Richard Bergfors, CEO MAX Burgers.

MAX takes over the approximately 550 sqm premises at Kungsgatan 4 on 1 December 2021. A period of renovation and interior design work will follow, with the restaurant scheduled to open in the fall of 2022.

"We're excited to be able to welcome MAX to our property on Kungsgatan. The MAX restaurant concept complements our existing offering extremely well and will strengthen Kungsgatan as a business street and vibrant meeting place at the heart of the city," says Emanuel Westin, Head of Business Development, Retail at Hufvudstaden.
