Misshumasshu to expand in Bibliotekstan

Chef duo Adam and Albin's Misshumasshu bar-restaurant concept on Birger Jarlspassagen in Bibliotekstan, central Stockholm, is set to expand. The Asia-inspired restaurant will expand to fill all the remaining premises on Birger Jarlspassagen, increasing its total area at the site to 750 square metres.

Misshumasshu is a restaurant concept with influences from Japan and other Asian cuisines. It is a popular destination for lunch, dinner and drinks. The concept is now being expanded and developed into Misshumasshu 2.0.
