About Kvarteret Johanna

Kvarteret Johanna is one of the most centrally located city blocks in Gothenburg, situated by the historic canals, just steps from Brunnsparken and the Central Station – with the iconic department store Nordiska Kompaniet as its nearest neighbour. The project is one of the largest developments underway in the inner city and will be an important addition to the revitalisation of the Fredstan district.

The redevelopment and new construction total approximately 32,000 square metres of space for offices, retail and restaurants. The block retains its architectural diversity outwardly, while internally all buildings are interconnected to enable highly flexible office solutions – from 150 sqm to over 4,300 sqm on a single floor. Completion is scheduled for 2026.

The name Johanna pays tribute to two Göteborg institutions – the statue "Johanna i Brunnsparken" and the legendary restaurant Johanna, once located on the site known as "Brända tomten." The block lies in Fredstan, at the very heart of central Gothenburg.

Three key service concepts will provide added value to future tenants:

- A rooftop restaurant by Stureplansgruppen, with panoramic views over the city
- A Nordic Wellness gym on Drottninggatan
- Hufvudstaden's own Cecil Coworking, offering private offices, shared workspaces and a large conference centre open to members and external guests
